

PARK RULES 2019

These Park Rules are in place for the good management of the park and the benefit of all who use it. These rules form part of the Agreement that is the contract between us for your occupation of accommodation on the park.

The expression "you/your" means the person and/or occupier and the expression "we/us/our" refers to the park owner and/or manager.

- 1. Quiet must be observed between the hours of 11pm and 8am
- 2. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times on the Holiday Park and any mess must be cleaned up
- 3. Dogs must not be left unattended at any time in accommodation or vehicles
- 4. You may BBQ and use either charcoal or gas but it is strictly prohibited to burn; wood, logs, burning blocks, kindling, paper, card or any other flammable material on the Park
- 5. If you use a disposable BBQ it should be raised off the ground but should not be placed on a picnic table, decking or any other wooden or plastic surface. These should be left to cool before disposing of them in a general waste bin.
- 6. The Adventure Play Park will be shut after 8pm and will not be re-opened until 9am. When the Adventure Play Park is shut no one is permitted to enter
- 7. The staff at the Park are there to assist wherever possible, any acts of violence or abuse towards any member of staff will not be tolerated
- 8. The following are not permitted anywhere on the Holiday Park
 - a. Fires and fire pits
 - b. Gazebos
 - c. Washing lines
 - d. Drones
 - e. Chinese lanterns
 - f. Kites
- 9. Ball games are not permitted in camping, touring, in between caravans or Skylight Cabins or on the green in the cul-desacs, there is a designated ball game area in the Adventure Play Park.
- 10. Clothes lines are not permitted to be strung up between accommodation or trees as these are a hazard
- 11. All vehicles brought onto the Park must abide by the following rules;
 - a. All cars must not exceed the 5mph speed limit
 - b. Each car must be MOTd and insured for driving on a public road according to the law
 - c. No car is allowed to cause any damage of any kind to the Park, e.g. leaking fluids, churning up grass etc.
 - d. All drivers must hold a full driving licence permitting them to drive cars on public roads in the UK (drivers with provisional licences are not permitted to drive on Park)
 - e. No car is allowed to be driven on Park while under the influence of alcohol or drugs
 - f. The repair, washing, maintenance and dismantling of vehicles of any kind is prohibited on Park
 - g. Not car should present a nuisance through excessive revving, warming up periods or otherwise.
 - h. Helmets must be worn at all times while riding a motorbike or bicycle
