

Park Rules

SEA VIEW CAMPERVAN PITCHES

Please take care while driving on the Holiday Park, the maximum speed limit on the Holiday Park is 10mph. There are speed humps to be aware of.

Check-in is from 13:00pm on your day of arrival, and check-out is no later than 11:00am on your day of departure.

Please be aware that there is a noise curfew at 11:00pm.

Please keep your pitch or camping area tidy at all times and remove any rubbish.

Wi-Fi is available in the Man O' War Bar & Restaurant.

You may have a barbecue using charcoal or gas. We do not allow disposable barbecues.

The Adventure Playground is available from 9am until dusk.

Please be aware the shower block will be closed between 10:30am and 11:30am for cleaning daily. During this time, there are toilets available to use in the Public Car Park.

Reception is open from 9am until late, 7 days a week.

Please speak to our Touring Warden, Deb, if you need any assistance at all. Deb's contact number is 07511181914, and she is available between the hours of 9am and 6pm, Friday to Tuesday.

The staff at the Park are here to assist wherever possible. Any inconsiderate behaviour will not be tolerated.

Pets must be kept on leads at all times and all dog waste disposed of immediately. Pets must not be left unattended at any time.

There are staff available to assist at the Reception between 9am and midnight. If you have any issues after this time please contact our security on 07563382684. Please make sure to call this number, texts are not monitored. In an emergency please call 999.

Please respect the following rules whilst staying on the sea view:

- Toilet chemical waste must only be disposed of at the Chemical Disposal Point labelled '2' on the map.
- Tents, windbreaks, and similar structures are not allowed on the sea view camper van pitches, this includes toilet tents.
- Please ensure you pitch either forwards or backwards on the pitch.
- Awnings must remain attached to the vehicle at all times, and cannot be left on the pitch.
- Please do not leave any items unattended on the pitch.
- You must sleep in a touring vehicle, this does not include cars, vans or sign-written vehicles.

Pitches are unallocated. Once you have arrived and pitched up, you can reserve this pitch for your stay by hiring a 'Reserved' sign from the Touring Wardens. Please do not pitch up on a pitch that already has a reserved sign.

The following are not permitted anywhere on the Holiday Park;

- Fires and Fire Pits
- Gazebos
- Washing Lines
- Drones
- Chinese Lanterns
- Kites
- Ball Games or frisbies
